

Registration Form and Payment Infos

Registration can be done per fax or mail. Please use this form, one for each person. You can load it down from our webpage www.kushido.ch. Registrations will be confirmed after payment has been received. If possible register as a group via your country head.

The Gashuku fee is CHF 450 if you register prior to 1st of May . Thereafter an extra CHF 50 will be charged. Registration closes on 30th of June. A deposit of CHF 200 is due with the registration, the remaining amount latest on arrival at the Gashuku. If you cancel prior to 30th of June, you get all money back except an administration fee of CHF 50. If you cancel afterwards the cancellation fee is CHF 200 (i.e. the deposit).

The Gashuku fee includes accommodation, food and drinks during meals and breaks from Saturday supper to the following Friday breakfast (including a Sayonara barbeque/braai on Thursday evening). Also included is a blackbelt appetiser on Saturday 2 o'clock before Gashuku (orientation of Gashuku program).

Not included are visits to restaurants or pubs in the evening.

We answer before you ask

- You get to Stansstad by train from Zurich Airport easily. Stansstad is also situated directly at the main north - south highway crossing Switzerland. The Gashuku will take place in the Stansstad townhall / sportscenter which is within a few minutes walking distance from the village centre, railway and ship station.

- Stansstad is right in the centre of one of the main tourist areas of Switzerland and offers excellent vacation opportunities, high mountains with glaciers and a beautiful lake, all sorts of sports and shopping and a well organized public transport system with railway, ships and cable cars.
- For the Gashuku you ought to bring with you:
 - Your Gi and your blue book
 - sleeping bag
 - walking shoes, swimming trunks ...
 - appropriate clothing: it will be summer which means temperatures could be between 35° and 20°C; take into account rain and wind
 - the usual things you need for a Gashuku, for holidays and/or an evening in a pub
- Accommodation in the Stansstad Dojo before / after the Gashuku can be arranged.
- Accommodation in a hotel, if you want to stay privately close to the Gashuku venue (maybe with your partner) can also be organized.
- Closer to the Gashuku date, there will be a list of all the confirmed Gashuku participants on our webpage
